Who Do You Say I am? Notes

Questions

- 1. In what ways does your confession of "Who Jesus is" serve as a life altering truth in your life?
- b. Take a moment to reflect personally on Jesus' identity, and how it shapes your life.
- 3. How can you cultivate a deeper and richer sense of Jesus' identity, so that you can solidify your confession even in the face of adversity and doubt?
- 4. Reflect on opportunities that you might have in sharing your confession to those who don't know Jesus.

### March 31, 2024

Happy Resurrection Sunday, McKernan! He is risen! This morning, Pastor Nathanael will be taking a look at Matthew 16:13-20 and answering the question that Jesus asks His disciples, "Who do you say I am?" Peter's response to this question marks a pivotal moment in the Gospel, emphasizing Peter's recognition of Jesus as the promised Messiah and the Son of God. Peter may not have fully grasped his own confession, but his words echo throughout history as a profound declaration of faith. By doing so, it reminds us of the significance of Jesus' identity and the transformative power that is found in His resurrection.

<sup>13</sup>Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" <sup>14</sup>And they said, "Some say John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." <sup>15</sup>He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" <sup>16</sup>Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." <sup>17</sup>And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. <sup>18</sup>And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock[b] I will build my church, and the gates of hell[c] shall not prevail against it. <sup>19</sup>I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed[d] in heaven." <sup>20</sup>Then he strictly charged the disciples to tell no one that he was the Christ. *- Matthew* 16:13-20 ESV
